Once again you have made me a heroine to upper management! You know how skeptical they were when I suggested bringing in an outside adjuster to assist us in handling the fire at our store on Bartow Avenue in the Bronx. It took all of my "power of persuasion" to get them to agree!

Now, of course, they are devotees of you and your staff as I have been through the years. Even though I consider myself a prudent Risk Manager, there are so many details that you thought of that we didn't. Your calculation of the business interruption portion of our loss was by far more accurate and advantageous to our bottom line than any number our accounting department came up with. Additionally, we could never have reconstructed the value of inventory totally destroyed without the experience and knowledge of your staff.

I was especially appreciative of the manner in which you negotiated with the insurance company adjuster. The broker will attempt to get a little more for us, but they have a certain loss ratio factor that controls the carrier's return of funds annually, so their allegiance is also self-directed.
